J.P. Biggers, Born 3/1/1844, Died 5/20/1927, Private, Company E 42nd Regiment, Georgia Infantry.

James M. Bowen, Born 9/1/1825 Died 4/1/1891, Married to Lucy Ann Kilgore in 1850, Private, Company I 55th Georgia Infantry.

Starling S. Bowen, Born 11/29/1839, Died 8/25/1918, Private, Company I 55th Georgia Infantry.

S.F. Brewer, Born 5/31/1837, Died 4/19/1879.

William T. Brock, Born 10/7/1850, Died 2/23/1945, Married, Private Company A, 42nd Georgia Infantry.

Samuel Dillard, Born 1816, Died 1906, Married to Serephene Boyd, Private Troop I, 16th Battalion, Ga. Cavalry

Thomas P. Dillard, Born 1847, Died 1903, Private, Troop C, 10th Georgia Cavalry Militia.

Robert Etheridge, Born 8/11/1835, Died 8/28/1917, Married to Mary Elizabeth Kilcrease. 2nd Lieutenant, Company I 55th Georgia Infantry.

Miles Charles Ewing, Born 8/12/1824, Died 3/12/1887, 1st Sgt., Company F 24th Georgia Infantry.

Reuben M. Higgins, Born 3/26/1820, Died 1/10/1863, Private, Company F 24th Georgia.

James Killcrease, Born 1841, Died 1914, Married to Emily Knight, Private, Company C 8th Georgia Militia.

W.F. Kirkpatrick, Company B 4th Georgia Militia

Elias W. Knight, Born 10/8/1820, Died 1/6/1897, Married to Margaret A (?) Private, Company C 8th Georgia Militia.

George L. Knight, Born 11/2/1845, Died 11/14/1938, Married to I.J. Knight, Private, Company I 55th Georgia Infantry.

Martin L. Knight, Born 6/9/1820, Died 4/22/1891, Married to Dedame Allison, Private, Company C 8th Georgia Militia.

Jacob C. Lowery, Born 6/11/1838, Died 6/25/1914 married 5 times. Wounded and lost leg, Company F 38th Tennessee Infantry.

J.A. McClung, Born 3/23/1839, Died 3/15/1899, Troop C 10th Georgia Cavalry Militia.

John O. Perry, Born 3/31/1821, Died 8/22/1881, Married to Louisa Reeves, Private, Troop C 10th Georgia Cavalry Militia.

William Taylor Pittman, Born 7/20/1837, Died 1/20/1913, Married to Charlottia, Private, Company I 16th Georgia Infantry.

George Washington Price, Born 1838, Died 1918, Married to Emma Dummond, Private, Troop I 16th Battalion Georgia Cavalry.

Fielding Rutherford, Born 1820, Died , Married to Martha Peavey in 1872, Private, Troop I Battalion Georgia Cavalry.

T. Sells, Born 5/22/1845, Died 5/29/1930, Private, Troop K, 16th Battalion Georgia Cavalry.

Joseph Sims, Born 10/18/1848, Died 3/9/1930, Private, Company I 55th Georgia Infantry.

F.M. Wages, Born 1/16/1831, Died 4/3/1915, Married to Lusinda Alison in 1852, 3rd Lieutenant, Company C 8th Georgia Militia.

N.L. Cole, Born, 9/11/1824, Died, 1885, wife of Osborn Cole who was a private in Company I, 16th Ga., Osborn died of disease during the war and was buried in the northeastern United States.

The following descriptions of some of the units these soldiers fought with are excerpted from CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS FROM GWINNETT COUNTY GEORGIA, compiled by J. Tracy Power and published by the Gwinnett Historical Society, Lawrenceville, Georgia, copyright 1975.

Company I, 55th Georgia Infantry

Organized May, 1862, in Lawrenceville by Capt. David A. Lee.

July, 1862, in Atlanta . . . February-March, 1863, with Gen. D.S. Donelson in Tennessee . . . April-June 1863 with Gen. W.G.M. Davis in Tennessee

July, 1863, with Gen. S.B. Buckner at Big Creek Gap, Tennessee

Guarded provisions at Knoxville, Tennessee in the summer of 1863.

Sent to Cumberland Gap, Tennessee August 3, 1863.

Sept. 9, 1863 surrendered with the army of Gen. J.W. Frazer at Cumberland Gap.

On February 24, 1864, the detachment that escaped capture at Cumberland Gap was consolidated into Companies A, B, C and sent to the Army of Tennessee as the "Detachment of 55th Regiment Georgia Infantry."

Detachment surrendered with Gen. Joseph E. Johnston at Greensboro, N.C., April 26, 1865.

Company A 42nd Georgia Infantry

Organized in Lawrenceville, March 4, 1862 by Captain Lovick P. Thomas

Troop I 16th Battalion Georgia Cavalry

Organized February, 10, 1864, at Bethany, Ga. Made up of men from Jackson, Gwinnett, Hall, and Fulton Counties. Mustered in by 2nd Lt. John M. Martin of Gwinnett. There were two Gwinnett officers and 43 Gwinnett privates.

Troop C 10th Georgia Cavalry Militia

Organized August 1, 1863. Mustered in by Lt. Col. S.B. Wright at Lawrenceville. Paid forty cents per day, for six months in Atlanta, Rome and Savannah.

Company F 24th Georgia Infantry

Organized in Lawrenceville, August 24, 1861, by Captain John H.F. Mattox. Attached to the Army of Northern Virginia under General Robert E. Lee. Winter 1861-1862 Washington, N.C. . . . March-May, 1862, Richmond, Virginia
It was in the battles of:

South Mountain, Md.

Antietam, Md. On Sept. 17, 1862, the regiment had many casualties in this battle.

Fredericksburg, Chancellorsville, Gettysburg, the Wilderness, Spotsylvania Court House, Cold Harbor, Petersburg, Five Forks, and Saylers Creek.

Surrendered April 9, 1865 at Appomattox Court House, Virginia

Company C 8th Georgia Militia

Mustered in on August 1, 1863, at Lawrenceville by Lt. Col. S.B. Wright. Six months duty at Atlanta, Rome, and Savannah.

Company I 16th Georgia Infantry

Organized in Lawrenceville July 16, 1861, by Captain Henry P. Thomas. This regiment was with Lee's Army of Northern Virginia throughout the war. November 1861-February 1862 at York County, Virginia . . . March-May 1862 near Richmond, Virginia . . . May-August 1862 at Drewry's Bluff, Virginia

It was in the battles of: Antietam and South Mountain, Md.

At Fredericksburg, on December 11-13, 1862, Cobb's Brigade, of which this regiment was a part, won fame by holding off repeated Union attacks.

At Chancellorsville and Gettysburg.

In Sept. 1863, it was on detachment with General James Longstreet in Tennessee

Fort Sanders, November 29, 1863--The 16th Ga.'s battle flag led the army into battle. The flag was captured. Lt. Col. Henry P. Thomas, formerly Captain, was killed.

It was in the battles of: Spotsylvania, the Wilderness, Cold Harbor, Petersburg, Five Forks, and Sayler's Creek.

Surrendered at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.

Troop K 16th Georgia Batallion Georgia Cavalry

Organized Feb. 10, 1864, at Bethany, GA. Made up of Gwinnett County men. Mustered in by 2nd Lieutenant John M. Martin of Troop I.

On March 23, 1864, the regiment was sent on a scouting expedition near Bull's Gap, Tennessee Attached to Longstreet's detachment of the Army of Northern Virginia

March-April 1864, with Longstreet in Tennessee.

August-October, 1864, with General J.H. Morgan in Western Virginia and Tennessee.

November, 1864, with General J.C. Breckinridge in Western Virginia and Tennessee.

Marling S. Jones, Born 11/29/1839, Died 5/25/1918, Private, Company I 5th Georgia Infantry.

R.P. Jones, Born 5/30/1837, Died 4/19/1879.

William T. Jones, Born 10/7/1850, Died 2/23/1895, Married, Private Company A 42nd Georgia Infantry.

Samuel G. Jones, Born 1815, Died 1905, Married to Seraphina Boyd, Private Troop L, 14th Battalion, Cav Cavalry.

Thomas R. Jones, Born 1847, Died 1903, Private, Troop C, 10th Georgia Cavalry Militia.

Robert C. Jones, Born 8/11/1835, Died 8/28/1917, Married to Mary Elizabeth Albrecht, 2nd Lieutenant, Company I 5th Georgia Infantry.

Walter Charles Jones, Born 8/12/1824, Died 3/12/1893, 1st Sgt., Company F 24th Georgia Infantry.

Samuel H. Jones, Born 3/26/1820, Died 1/10/1883, Private, Company F 24th Georgia Infantry.

John H. Jones, Born 1841, Died 1914, Married to Sally Knight, Private, Company C 3th Georgia Militia.

W.P. Kirkpatrick, Company B 4th Georgia Militia.

Elias W. Knight, Born 12/3/1820, Died 1/6/1877, Married to Margaret A. Private, Company C 3th Georgia Militia.

George L. Knight, Born 11/2/1845, Died 11/14/1936, Married to Mary Knight, Private, Company I 5th Georgia Infantry.

Walter L. Knight, Born 9/18/1828, Died 1/22/1891, Married to Lucinda Allison, Private, Company D 4th Georgia Militia.

Samuel L. Knight, Born 8/11/1836, Died 8/25/1914, Married 3 times, Wounded and 10 times, Company F 38th Tennessee Infantry.
